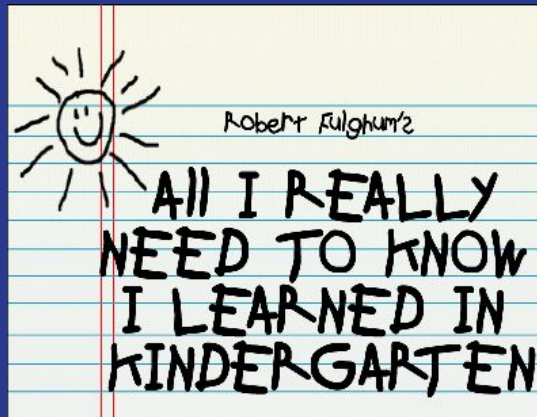

Young Fives Program

- Additional time for emotional, social, intellectual and physical growth through learning activities that foster development.
- Builds on expanded preschool elements that work to prepare the child for their upcoming kindergarten experience.
- Altered kindergarten curriculum while taking the necessary time to ensure students understand concepts at a developmentally appropriate pace.
- Extended play and sensory-based approach.



Weekly/Daily Activities

- ★ Snack Time
- ★ Lunch/Lunch Recess (35 minutes daily)
